Monitoring Requirements Not Met for East Dunkard Water Authority

Our water system violated several drinking water standards over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During September 2018 we did not complete all monitoring or testing and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for during the last year, how often we are supposed to sample for Coliform Bacteria and Distribution Chlorine Residuals and how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which follow-up samples were (or will be) taken.

Coliform Bacteria	4/month	2	September 2018	Nov 12, 2018
Distribution Chlorine Residuals	4/month	2	September 2018	Nov 12, 2018

What happened? What was done?

Samples were overlooked due to working on an exposed water main project that needed to be covered to alleviate a break. Resampling was done on Nov 12, 2018 and samples showed we are meeting drinking water standards
